Breakfast club is open from 8am to 9am. We will be acting upon advice and will be closing the doors at **8.15** rather than 8.30 to allow us to maintain the correct staffing levels in the hall. No children will be permitted to breakfast club after that time.

It is very important, due to the timescales, to post or email back the attached form to school at your earliest convenience and before the start of the new term.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Free Breakfast Club Initiative

Welsh Government and Caerphilly County Borough Council have made a commitment to provide, for all children of primary school age who are registered in maintained primary schools, to have a free healthy breakfast at school each day.

It is not intended to replace breakfast already provided by parents/guardians, but to allow all those children who for whatever reason have not had breakfast at home to have one in school.

Our aim is to help improve the health and concentration of children, and to assist in the raising of standards of learning and attainment.

This club is available to all children registered at the school. Before registering your child you need to be aware of the following procedures.

What do we have to do?

If you would like your child/children to attend breakfast session when they start at this school, you must complete the attached form and return it to the school at your earliest convenience. If we do not receive a response we will assume that you do not wish your child/children to attend breakfast sessions. Please note that a free breakfast is not a right. Schools can refuse entry to children in conjunction with the school behaviour policy.

- Access for children to Breakfast Club is not available until 8am, with doors closing at 8.15am and the provision will run until 9am.
- It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child/ren does not arrive in school prior to this time and are handed over in a safe and appropriate manner to a member of the Breakfast Club Team.
- All access is via the main school entrance, where a member of the team will be waiting to receive your child.
- Once your child has entered the club they must remain in the Breakfast Club session until the start of school.
- Breakfast Club will **only admit children who have been officially registered**. This is to ensure that all pupils are insured and adequately supervised.

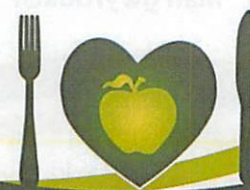
